As part of this course you will keep a "Photojournal" of your independent explorations of photography.

You must present 5 new photos approximately every two weeks. Your teacher will give you the due dates for these. The subject matter for your photos is completely up to you and should reflect your interest in image making.

For the presentation and record keeping of your project you will create a website using WIX or an equivalent free website developer. Find the assignment sheet that explains this further on our website. In short you may customize the website anyway you want but you MUST have a visible menu item on the first page that will bring to your Photo-journal "sub page" of your website. From that sub-page I should be able to navigate to whatever entry or "due date" that I want. The photos must be presented in a "gallery view" with a black or white background and the ability to scroll from one photo to the next in your entry with ease, either using the cursor keys or an arrow icon on the page.

Every time you have a photo-shoot due, create a post with at least 5 images and title it with the date. Of course this date should correspond with the due date and NOT the date that you actually submit the photos (should that not correspond to the actual due date).

Send your teacher a link to your website to his email address: dlong @vsb.bc.ca (make sure it is a link to your account and not an individual post.

He will create a link to your Website on the Point Grey Art blog.

Your teacher will mark all submissions shortly after the due date. If you submit your photos late you will be responsible, BEFORE the next due date, to come in during FIT to have your account marked. No late marks will be deducted provided you follow instructions.

Website Evaluation:

/5 Creativity: creative aspects of project are recognized and taken advantage of.

/5 Usability: website is well organized and easy to navigate.

/5 Criteria: All instructions followed and completed by due date.
