

Psychogeographic Map Project



You will work to create a watercolour and ink map of a country, city, or area that is important to you. You should choose a place you have actually been to, and one that you have a personal connection with. Your map will have at least 5 illustrations in it. This means that you will pick at least 5 places in your map where you will add extra detail and focus.

Project Breakdown:

1. Watercolour technique practice
2. Planning your project (*preliminary sketches of your idea for the project*)
3. A finished, illustrated map of a place that is important to you.
4. Group Chat

- practiced the watercolour techniques we have done in class
- made **practice sketches and a plan** for your map project
- completed a watercolour and ink map
- chosen a place that you have a clear, personal connection to
- illustrated (*added more detail and focus*) to **at least 5 places on your map**
- used **more than 1 watercolour technique** on your map
- continued to develop your ideas, skills, and your final work to the best of your ability
