## SIMPLE T-SHIRT DESIGN OPTIONS

Follow the instructions contained in the "Prepping Graphics for T-shirts" button on the Graphics 12 web page.
Probably a good idea to double check with your teacher about whether or not your design will work.
DO NOT use other people's designs (of course!)
Designs should generally be $12^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ to be a full size t-shirt design.

## JUST TEXT

Create a design for a shirt that contains only text.
This could be a favourite: Phrase, band, truism, quote, Joke - whatever - easy!
You can type out the text or draw it and scan it, OR you could draw your own text design

## LOGO

What about your black and white Logo design? That would be super cool.
Symbols from the Design elements book

## POSTERIZED PHOTO

Take a black and white photo (or desaturate a colour photo in Photoshop) that has a lot of contrast (or increase the contrast in Photoshop through levels: command C). subject it to the Posterizing filter. Does it look cool? Make a shirt out of it.

## SYMBOL PATTERN

Create a pattern design using the Symbols available from the design elements. Ask your teacher where these are 'cause I don't know yet.
There are arrows and asterixis, snowflakes, hearts, targets and lots more! You could make some pretty cool stuff with them.
