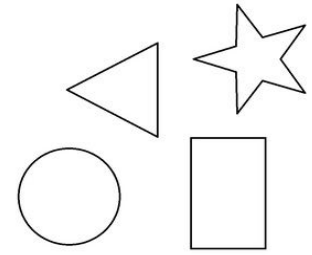


## Practice with Stencils!

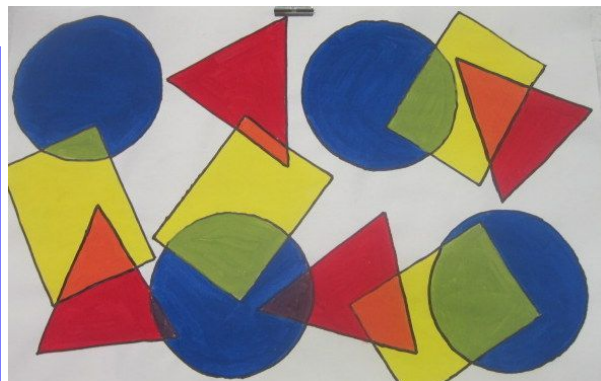
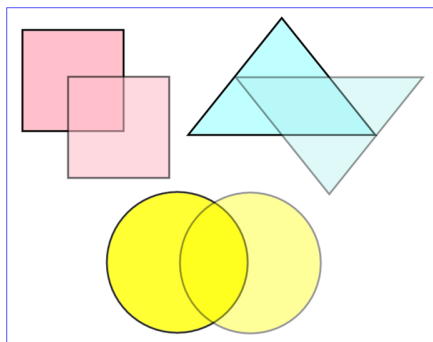
- ❑ **Step 1:** Cut out **3 different shapes** (*circle, square, triangle, star, etc.*) on your card paper. Use an x-acto knife and a ruler to cut out your 3 shapes.



- ❑ **Step 2:** Use **acrylic paint** and a **stencil brush** to print your shapes on a piece of paper. Practice making your prints as clean as possible.



- ❑ **Step 3:** Try **layering** your shapes on top of each other: When you layer stencils, you start with the lightest colour first. Apply your **first shape** in a light colour and let it dry. Now apply your **second shape**, in another colour over your first shape. After letting it dry again, layer your **third shape** somewhere over top of the other two shapes.



- ❑ **Step 4:** Put your **name** on your practice paper and put it in the drying rack.
