Summary: You will complete a charcoal drawing of a body in motion. You will use a photograph that you took for this assignment. You will draw a body making a motion blur as it moves. You will demonstrate what you have learned about figure drawing, proportion, movement, and value.

Medium: You will use charcoal to complete your drawing. Charcoal is a great material to show a motion blur because it can be easily smudged and creates soft edges.

Subject: Your drawing should feature at least one human figure that is moving. The photo could be of someone dancing, playing sports, running, etc.

Techniques: Apply what you have learned about proportion, figure drawing, movement, and value in your final drawing. You are using these techniques to show movement.
