

## WRITING ABOUT YOUR PHOTOGRAPH FOR CHESTERFIELDS

Keep it **short**

Keep it **simple**

Keep it *elegant*

Don't overexplain

Don't say anything that the Jury will already know.

Don't say anything like: "My Photo fits the theme "Look Again" because..."

Remember: the jury and the patrons (audience) KNOW the theme – they will already be primed to look at your image through the lens of "Look Again".

If you are an experienced or confident writer then just go for it and

Review the resources you have been provided and be very clear how your Photo addresses the theme. Look for vocabulary that might help you to describe your idea.

You could try:

Asking a question of the reader that might lead to a revealing answer:

Do you see...?

What is the photographers role? Is it to...?

What is 1/500 of a second?

Or a statement:

A camera sees differently than we do.

A photograph can reveal things that we would never notice.

Or something like that...
