

LETTERING IN 3-D

(ONE POINT PERSPECTIVE)

① begin by drawing your name in block letters across a sheet of paper
 use a ruler + french curve if you'd like.

eg: → **DEAN**

be as neat as possible

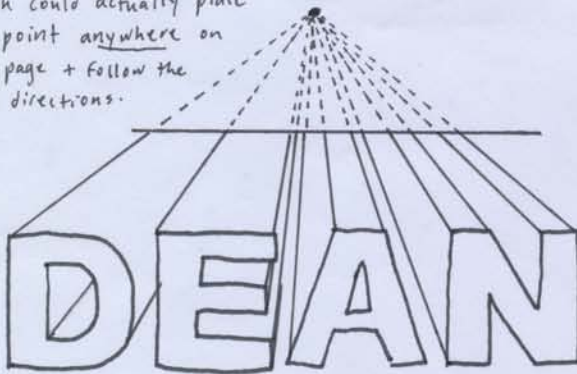
② draw a point around 2 inches directly above your name. Draw straight lines directly from that point to all corners of your letters.



oh - and use pencil for now.

③ 1/2 way between your point and the top of your letters draw a straight line parallel to the top of your word. erase all lines above this line

tip: you could actually place the point anywhere on your page + follow the same directions.



④ At the point where the horizon line meets with the projecting lines draw a line at the angle of of the same curve as the closest side of that letter.



erase all unnecessary lines, go over in fine liner, colour.

CREATING A COVER PAGE

USING THE ABOVE LESSON IN 3-D LETTERING.

1. COMPLETE THE LESSON ABOVE. CUT OUT. CAREFULLY.
2. TAKE A PICTURE (OR HAVE A PICTURE TAKEN) OF YOURSELF. MAKE IT A HEAD OR TORSO SHOT WITH ROOM (NEGATIVE SPACE) AT THE TOP OR BOTTOM.
3. PRINT IT OUT IN BLACK + WHITE AT 8 1/2 x 11". YOU MAY NEED TO ADJUST THE IMAGE SIZE IN PHOTO SHOP.
4. PASTE YOUR NAME ON THE SELF-PORTRAIT. HAND IN!
